


The cost of shipping from overseas surges



High summer booking demand leads to increased rates

- Extended lead times are pushing customers to choose expedited shipping, causing higher rates due to the increased demand for faster delivery.
- A drought in Panama lowered water levels in the canal, reducing the amount of cargo that ships can carry, causing delays and elevated costs.
- The Yemen Conflict continues to disrupt maritime routes through the Suez Canal.





EU Deforestation Regulation begins December 30, 2024



New regulations aim to prevent EU citizens from consuming products that contribute to global deforestation

- At the end of December 2024, companies selling certain materials in the EU markets must prove that their products are not linked to deforestation.
- Crops from our industry that may fall under this regulation are palm, (including oleochemicals such as glycerin, capric/caproic acid), soy, coffee, and cocoa.
- Our suppliers have committed to complying with these new regulations to minimize potential supply issues as these new regulations take effect.





Orange growers experience challenges





Supply shortfalls expected

- Orange crops have suffered due to extreme heat, low rainfall, and the El Niño weather pattern.
- Growers have suffered serious challenges due to a high rate of premature fruit drop and an increase in diseases such as citrus greening.
- The reduced supply of raw materials has caused a significant shortfall in orange terpenes, orange oils, and derivatives including d-limonene.
